Reynolds Secondary School of the Greater Victoria School Districts is seeking Expressions of Interest from local farmers to provide fresh produce for their LUNCH Program (inspired by the Farm to School Program).

The LUNCH Program will connect Reynolds with local farms with the objectives of serving healthy meals in schools, improving student nutrition, providing health and nutrition education opportunities, and supporting local small scale farmers.

Reynolds will purchase food from local farmers which will be offered to the students in the form of a salad bar. Students will be involved in the preparing of the salads and are provided with the opportunity to purchase the fresh, local salads from the school cafeteria.

Benefits to the local farms include a viable market in the community to sell produce and an opportunity to expand customer base by building a connection with a local school.

Requirements:

One delivery of fresh seasonal produce per week for the month of May 2011 for approximately 200 students.

One delivery of fresh seasonal produce per week beginning September 2011 through to June 2012 for approximately 200 –300 students.
